Pages checked

Link issues

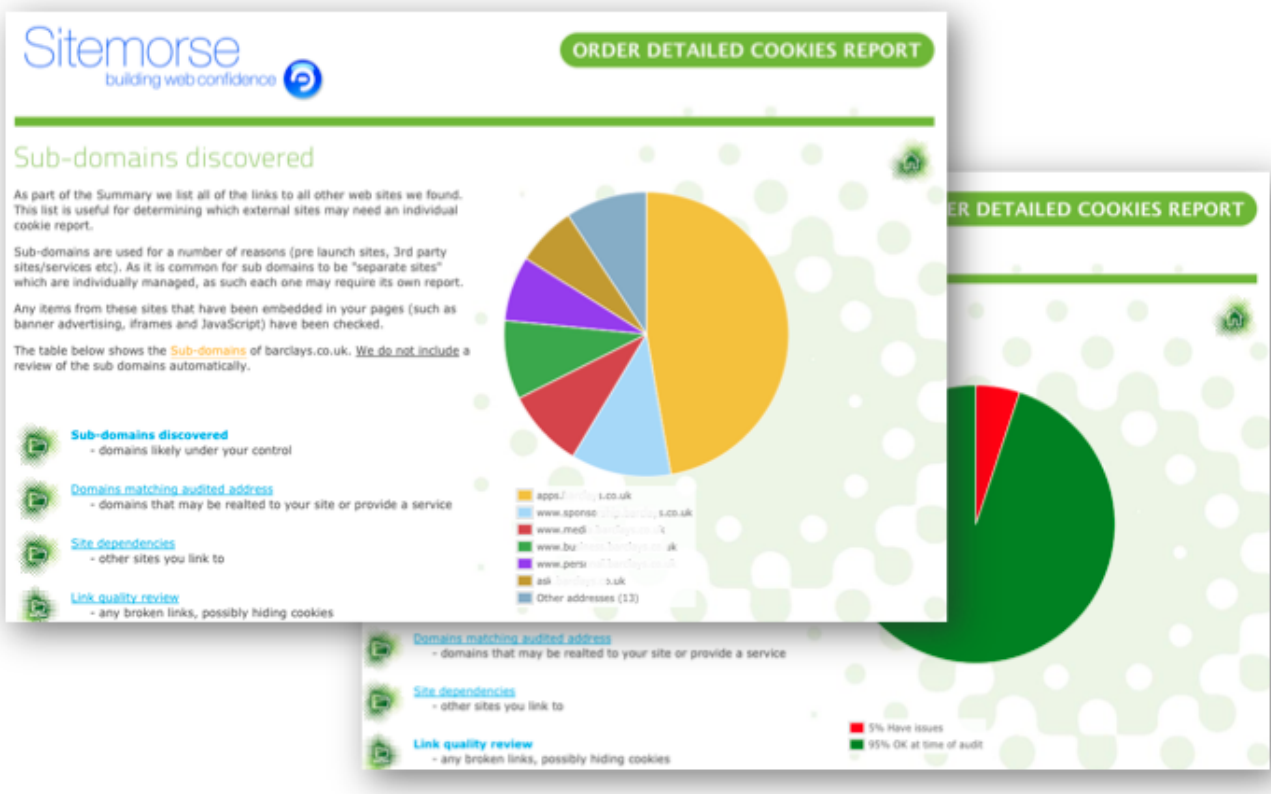

Domain
The domain name to which the cookie applies.

The first page we saw that set the cookie. If this page is not on your site then the chain of URLs that lead to this page from your site are also displayed. The first address listed (s?ukws...) is the web address that set the cookie. The last address (/stayahead) is the page on your site that included this content.

Path
Section of the site the cookie applies to.


Name
The name of the cookie found. For your own cookies this hopefully is a name your web team will recognize.

 Is the secure flag set?
Is the cookie only sent over secure (encrypted) connections.

Expiry
This is the expiry date observed when we ran this audit. However, please note that expiry dates of cookies are very often dynamically set.

You will have to log back in (if login is required) or select your preferences/themes again if the site uses these features. A new session cookie will be generated, which will store your browsing information and will be active until you leave the site and close your browser.

persistent cookies found

Persistent cookies help websites remember your information and settings for any future visits. This results in faster and more convenient access since, for example, you don't have to login again.

Besides authentication, other website features made possible by persistent cookies include: language selection, theme selection, menu preferences, internal site bookmarks or favorites, among many others. On your first visit, the website is presented in default mode. During your visit, you select your preferences and these preferences are remembered, through the use of the persistent cookie, the next time you visit the site.

For example, a website may offer its contents in different languages. On your first visit, you may choose to have the content delivered in French and the site may record that preference in a persistent cookie set on your browser. When you revisit that site it will use the cookie to ensure that the content is delivered in French. A persistent cookie enables a website to remember you on subsequent visits, speeding up or enhancing your experience of services or functions offered.

For manual inspection we include the details of all forms found. Submitting a form may result in session or persistent cookies being set in the browser, perhaps after validating authentication credentials and granting access to a client area. Often forms consist of a sequence of stages and may supply the option to store the state of a form for future ease of use.

We found **47** forms when checking your site - details are available upon request.

We submitted **38** GET forms with their default values as part of the scan. (POST forms are generally not submitted as they may cause the website to take a significant action, such as sending an email or posting a comment.)
