

**THE CHICHESTER DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES)
(CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION No. 2) ORDER 2014**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, sections 32 and 35

Chichester District Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the West Sussex County Council in accordance with s.39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

PART 1

GENERAL

Title

1. This order may be cited as the Chichester District Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Variation No. 2) Order 2014 and shall hereinafter be known as the 'Order'.

Commencement and Citation

2. This Order shall come into operation on the Seventh day of January 2015 ("the First Commencement Date") save in respect of paragraph 6 of Part 2 below, which shall come into force on the First day of April 2015 ("the Second Commencement Date").
3. Save as varied by this Order the Chichester District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2012 ("the 2012 Order"), as itself varied by the Chichester District Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Variation) Order 2014 ("the 2014 Order") shall continue to apply.

4. With effect from the First Commencement Date, the 2012 Order as amended by the 2014 Order shall have effect with the variations specified in Part 2 hereof save in respect of paragraph 6 below.
5. With effect from the Second Commencement Date, the 2012 Order as amended by the 2014 Order and as amended by paragraph 4 above shall have effect with the further variations specified in paragraph 6 of Part 2 hereof.

PART 2

VARIATIONS

1. The following new definitions shall be inserted into paragraph 2 of the 2012 Order as follows:

“pay and display parking place”

Means a parking place listed as such in Schedule 7 to this Order where the owner must obtain a parking ticket at the time the vehicle has been parked.

“pay on foot parking place”

A Parking Place listed as such in Schedule 7 to this Order where:

- *A pay on foot parking ticket is issued by a ticket machine located at the entrance to a parking place;*
- *The ticket is retained by the vehicle owner and need not be displayed;*
- *The relevant charge is paid as required at the parking place before returning to the vehicle and the ticket is presented to a machine upon exiting the parking place.*

“pay on foot parking ticket”

Means a ticket issued by a machine upon entry to a pay on foot parking place

2. The following words shall be inserted at the start of paragraph 32 of the 2012 Order:

Paragraphs 32 to 41 shall apply only to a pay and display parking place

3. A new paragraph 32A shall be inserted as follows:

If the ticket machine so requires, the driver of the vehicle shall, in addition to paragraph 32, enter the exact registration number of the vehicle into the ticket machine. The parking ticket issued thereafter shall be valid only for the registration number entered and if the registration number shall have been entered incorrectly, the parking ticket shall be invalid.

4. New paragraphs 41A, B, C, D and E shall be inserted into the 2012 Order as follows:

41A. The following paragraphs 41B to 41E (inclusive) shall apply only to a pay on foot parking place as listed in Schedule 7:

41B. The driver of a vehicle using a pay on foot parking place shall, unless the vehicle has the benefit of an exemption specified in Article 47 of this Order:

- (i) Upon arriving at the pay on foot parking place, take a pay on foot parking ticket from the machine to establish the date and time of entry;*
- (ii) On returning to the vehicle prior to exiting the parking place:
 - a. Pay in accordance with the scale of current charges (for the time during which the vehicle was parked) at the relevant pay station which will validate the pay on foot parking ticket allowing it to be used to exit the parking place;*
 - b. Within a period of grace of 15 (fifteen) minutes, proceed with the vehicle to the exit point for the parking place;*
 - c. Insert the pay on foot parking ticket into the machine at the exit barrier to enable egress from the parking place;**
- (iii) Or pay the attendant on duty, or a person nominated by the Council at the exit point, a parking fee in accordance with the scale of current charges;*

41C. In the event that a driver of a vehicle is unable to produce a pay on foot parking ticket obtained from the machine as aforesaid the person in charge of vehicle will be liable for the all day charge applicable in the parking place as specified in the scale of current charges to enable the vehicle to exit the parking place.

41D. Any pay on foot parking ticket is not transferable between one vehicle and another, or between one parking place and another.

41E. In respect of those vehicles to which the exemption under paragraph 47 (as amended by paragraph 5 below) applies, the driver of a vehicle shall:

- (i) Upon arriving at the pay on foot parking place, take a pay on foot parking ticket from the machine to establish the date and time of entry;*
- (ii) On returning to the vehicle prior to exiting the parking place:
 - a. The driver shall not be required to pay at the relevant pay station but shall instead proceed directly with the vehicle to the exit point for the parking place;*
 - b. A vehicle number plate recognition system shall read the number plate of the vehicle and, provided the exact number plate of the vehicle is registered as being permitted to use a parking permit or season ticket, the exit barrier shall permit the vehicle to egress the parking place;**

For the avoidance of doubt, if the vehicle registration number is not registered with the Council or the registration number is incorrectly registered, the driver of the vehicle shall be required to follow the procedure and pay the charges set out in clause 41B above.

For the further avoidance of doubt, pay on foot parking places shall not contain motorcycle bays and drivers of a motorcycle shall be required to pay in the same manner as any other vehicle.

5. Paragraph 47(i) to the 2012 Order shall be deleted. For the avoidance of doubt, holders of a valid disabled person's badge shall be required to pay the daily charge in accordance with the 2012 Order (as amended) from the date this Order comes into force;
6. A new Schedule 7 shall be inserted into the 2012 Order as set out in Schedule 7 to this Order.
