Description:	Sound mirror, c.1916. Converted into house by late 1930's. Sound mirror built of reinforced concrete, the shuttered lifts to the exterior clearly visible. House has slate-clad stud walls and corrugated asbestos roof, with 2 windows and window inserted into left-side wall.

Reason for Risk:	General deterioration after years of neglect.

Priority
