<b>Last Assessed:</b>	25 October 2012
<b>Ownership:</b>	Private
<b>Current Status:</b>	Stone in reasonable condition, repointing required in places. Major fractures to north wall due to roof spread. Broken tie beam to internal bay. Extensive plant growth, particularly to south-east corner.
