

## Measuring from plans

Within Chichester District, outside of the South Downs National Park (SDNP), plans associated with planning applications may be scaled using the Council's Online Measuring Tool. Where there is a need to measure plans offline and for measuring plans relating to applications within the SDNP there is an alternative free product; FOXIT Reader produced by Foxit Software that allows users to download the PDF version of scaled plans and measure them whether or not they are connected to the internet.

The reader can be downloaded from the off site link called Foxit software Reader. When installing the software we recommend that you select the "Make Default PDF Viewer" and "Run in Browser" options.
