Would benefit from cross referencing to policies in the Chichester Local Plan and also to cross referencing Neighbourhood Plan policies to provide comprehensive coverage. Some of the policies appear to replicate policies in the local plan.

Page 18: Policy 1 – Heritage Assets and their Setting

Reference is made to the "continued presence of houseboats in the Chichester Canal will be supported". Some further clarification of this would be helpful.

Is there any background to the identification of what is special about the buildings that are listed? The NPPF makes reference to non-designated heritage assets, however it would be helpful to understand how the buildings included have been identified and what is their significance.

Page 19: Policy 2 - Archaeological Sites

Policy should be clarified to add the words 'where appropriate'.

Page 21: Policy 3 -Habitat Sites

This is supported.

Second para reference to English Nature (now Natural England). However, the Government has now removed the GI Guidance from the National Planning Practice Guidance - document may need to be update to reflect this.

Map on Page 20 would benefit from a key to make it clear what the different types of sites are.

Policy should include reference to 'unless appropriate mitigation'.

Page 22: Policy 4 - Landscape Character and Important Views

Particular areas have been indicated and it is important that these are defined on a map to avoid any ambiguity when considering planning applications.

The second para states 'any development that intrudes into the landscape character must be appropriate'. This is not precise; some definition of what is appropriate needs to be included.

Page 22: Policy 5 – Light Pollution

What is definition of dark skies based on? Suggest his should be sourced as footnote.

Page 24: Policy 7 - Integration and Sense of Community

Concern as to whether or not the first sentence is appropriate or achievable? Would not be able to involve residents as suggested. Would be better to state that new residential development will be designed to encourage use by both future residents of the development and existing local residents.

<u>Page 25</u>: Policy 8 – Retention of Assets of Community Value and Other Facilities
A positive policy that recognises community assets and also the Register of Community
Assets held by Chichester District Council. However, the document needs to be clear with regard to the aspirations of the parish for these assets and linked to the content of the Action Plan table on Page 41.

Page 26: Policy 9 - Traffic Impact

It is not reasonable to include imprecise criteria such as 'measures agreed with residents' as decisions would be made by WSCC. A list of the potential mitigation measures that the village would like to see/to be considered could be included in the neighbourhood plan.

Page 27: Policy 10 - Footpaths and Cycle Paths

CIL will be covering this once it is introduced.

More details, either in the text or as an appendix, would identify what is expected. A map (see also comment below) showing potential and existing routes would be of assistance and help to identify where funding should be directed.

The aspiration to 'provide' a cycle path for commuting to Chichester could be more precisely phrased. It might strengthen the policy if the aspiration was more specific and included a plan/map. The Green Links across Manhood (a sub-group of the MPP) also has aspirations for a network of cycleways and footpaths etc. It would add strength if the aspirations from both groups were aligned through related documents such as the Neighbourhood Plans. Likewise the aspiration for a cyclepath to Chichester ought to align with the parish abutting the north of Birdham.

Page 28: Policy 11 – Village Severance

Second bullet point – should this refer to 'connected **and** permeable'? (i.e. insert the word 'and' rather than 'or') Assume the intention is that it is not one or the other?

Page 29: Policy 12 - Housing Development

Amend reference as under para 3.5. Reference to social housing under Rowan Nursery needs to be removed as social housing is no longer delivered.

It may be helpful to refer to Policy 13 (Settlement Boundary) as well as Policy 14 (Windfall) as this identifies how the sites are to be employed to meet the housing numbers.

Page 30: Policy 13 – Settlement Boundary

Wording referring to 'future version of that policy' should be removed. Reference should be made to new Local Plan policies.

Page 31: Policy 14 – Windfall Sites

Suggest that policy wording should be improved to refer more accurately to 'sites' rather than 'plots'.

Reference to open views suggests a blanket form of coverage whereas 'any key views' as identified in Policy 4 is more relevant to the Policy. A cross reference to Policy 4 could then also be added.

Page 31: Policy 15 – Rural Area Policy

Need clarity in relation to the definition of a 'rural area'. Wording should identify the 'rural area' as the area outside the settlement boundary or amend the policy to refer to 'area outside the settlement policy boundary'.

The policy is generally fairly restrictive and repeats policy in the Local Plan. Certain aspects are contrary to the NPPF, in that conversion would only be for agricultural workers dwellings.

Page 32: Policy 16 – Housing Density and Design

Parking requirements are beyond the parking requirements set by WSCC therefore local evidence is needed to support this requirement.

The Chichester Harbour Conservancy Design Guidelines have only been endorsed for the area within the AONB.

Page 33: Policy 17 - Housing Need

Reference to social housing needs to be removed as it is no longer delivered. In view of recent Government Policy changes and lack of clarification the text (relating to affordable housing quotas) page 33 under policy 17 should be removed.

Page 34: Policy 18 – Flood Risk Assessment

CDC currently use the EA flood maps as the SFRA maps are out of date, this is referred to in the text.

Page 36: Policy 21 – Wastewater Disposal

Second para should be amended to replace words 'in time' to 'prior to first occupation'.

Page 37: Policy 22 – Development for Business Use

Should not restrict the type of business taking over current sites and requiring different buildings outside the settlement area. This is in order to future proof any current business areas, if there is a downturn in one business area, another area may want to/need to expand.

If outside the AONB would not be able to require conformity with the Chichester Harbour Conservancy design guidelines

Page 38: Policy 23 – Retention of Businesses

Some repetition in regards to the retention of marine based businesses. Last sentence of paragraph 1 could be removed and the second paragraph expanded to include marine "heritage".

The inclusion of the village shop and post office does not seem appropriate as it would be better as part of a protection policy aimed at retaining community facilities subject to viability. (see Policy 38 of Chichester Local Plan).

Page 38: Policy 24 – Broadband and Telecommunications

Support policy; it will make the area more economically sustainable as companies increasingly rely on the internet for the success of their business.

Reference to other policies in the Neighbourhood Plan that relate to impact of development as would be beneficial as it is difficult to be precise as to what is meant by 'in or near open landscapes'.

Page 41: Action Plan Table

This needs amplification in terms of the content of the list as well as amendments to the final column which would benefit from amending the title to 'Source of Funding' to allow reference to be made to, for example Section 106, CIL, parish etc. This would assist in directing funds appropriately.

Community and Leisure Proposal - Currently only lists Proposal 1 for the playing field. Need to amplify in accordance with comments made above in relation to Policy 8 to include reference to community assets etc. as necessary.

For example, add reference to church extension as referred to in para 3.3

Page 44: 7.3 Maps - key Assets map - Policy 8

Assume that this is meant to identify key Community Assets therefore add the word 'community' to title.

They do not seem to have taken on any of our comments.

As far as I can see they still have not mentioned S106 community facilities contributions or the village hall other than it exists. Although on page 39 they do state that 'developers would be expected to contribute towards such schemes (Village Playing Field including the draining which has been in the CFA for years) and the Parish Council will draw up a plan as to how the funds should be spent during the lifetime of the plan' which they had previously.

Nor have they mentioned BI/07/05640/FUL -Longmeadow, Main Rd (27 dwellings) – CFC £20,738 or BI/12/04141/OUT – Land south east of Coppice Barn, Church Lane which was dismissed at appeal but will probably come back (they usually do).

Considering the community facilities contribution that will be due from the planning applications below or the one we still have yet to spend (£20,739), this is a sizeable contribution not to reference for either spend or identified need.

- Rowan Nursery, Bell Lane CFC = £41,475
- Land at Tawny Nurseries, Bell Lane CFC = £49,770.00

I am assuming they have forgotten/do not fully understand S106 community facilities contributions!

Here are our comments on the Birdham NP.

Policy 1

- "The continued presence of houseboats in the Chichester Canal will be supported". Do they want more, or just to retain those already there? Would they be happy with replacements? Any criteria for replacing? Further clarification required.
- Are all the heritage assets selected?

Policy 2

Policy should be clarified to add the words 'where appropriate'.

Policy 3 and supporting map

- Map should have a key to make it clear what the different types of sites are (page 20).
- Reference to 'unless appropriate mitigation' should be included in the policy.

Policy 4

- Particular areas have been identified would be easier to understand in map format with views and view points. What if a view is missing should include the words 'including' or 'for example'.
- Second para states 'any development that intrudes into the landscape character must be appropriate'. This is not very precise – what is appropriate?

Policy 7

• Final sentence – is this appropriate or even achievable? Can't do something like this in conjunction with local residents. Would be better read that it will be designed to encourage use by both future residents of the development and existing local residents.

Policy 9

• Will be difficult to agree mitigation measures with the residents – logistics of this would be very hard. Think mitigation should be down to WSCC. WSCC could be informed by a list of potential mitigation measures that the village would like to see/to be considered and this list could be include this list in the NP.

Policy 10

Cil will be covering this when it is introduced.

Policy 15

- conversions would only be for agricultural workers dwellings, which is contrary to the NPPF.
- Very restrictive policy. Similar issue in Loxwood NP would be worth looking at the comments the Loxwood Examiner made on this type of policy.

Policy 16

- Parking requirements beyond the parking requirements set by WSCC. Do they have the evidence to support this requirement?
- Not sure they can require all housing to be designed in accordance with the harbour conservancy design guidelines – when outside the AONB. May be able to make reference to outside AONB follow the principles of the guidelines.

Policy 17

• I will leave housing to comment on this policy.

Policy 18 and supporting text

• We are currently using the EA flood maps as the SFRA maps are out of date. I note their comments in the supporting text on this issue.

Policy 21

• 2nd para – change words 'in time' to prior to occupation

Policy 22

• If outside the AONB not sure can require conformity with the Chichester Harbour Conservancy design guidelines

7.6 - Position Statement on Wastewater
