Thank you for consulting us on the above Neighbourhood Plan. Apologies for the delay in our response to the Wisborough Green Neighbourhood Plan. I understand that the formal consultation closed last week but I hope that following comments may be of use.

We aim to reduce flood risk, while protecting and enhancing the water environment. We have had to focus our detailed engagement to those areas where the environmental risks are greatest.

We are pleased to see that throughout the Neighbourhood Plan there is recognition of the importance of climate change and the natural environment

We are pleased to see that the proposed allocations have been directed to the areas at the lowest probability of flooding and that any future development is directed to Flood Zone 1.

We support the intention of Policy IN1 with regard to Surface Water Management however we would recommend that some consideration is given as to how the policy would be implemented, for example who would be asked to appraise any Surface Water Management Plan that accompanies a planning application.

We would recommend that environmental infrastructure, including habitat enhancements, water storage areas, and green space, is taken into account when looking to fund local infrastructure.
