## Local elections are on their way – be ready to vote!

Local parish and district council elections will take place on Thursday 2 May 2019 and it's your chance to choose who you want to represent your community.

To cast your vote, you'll need to be registered by **midnight** on **Friday 12 April 2019.** 

- **Postal voting:** if you want to vote by post, you must submit an application form by **5pm** on **Monday 15 April 2019**.
- **Proxy votes:** if you want someone else to vote on your behalf, you need to submit an application form by **5pm** on **Wednesday 24 April 2019**.
- Changing existing postal, proxy or postal proxy votes: you must do this in writing by 5pm on Monday 15 April 2019.

**Emergency proxy vote:** this is for work or medical emergency reasons only and will need to be verified by a manager or medical professional. The deadline to register is **5pm** on **Thursday 2 May 2019**.
