We are extremely concerned with the inadequacy of the pumping station at Nutbourne, the inadequacy of the capacity of waste water treatment at Southern Water's Thornham Plant, and the inability of local pumping stations to cope with the existing demand on sewerage and wastewater. Living in School Lane we know how often the local pumping station at Nutbourne has to be pumped out as it cannot cope with existing demand. We objected to the original wastewater proposal for Priors Orchard development, and the use of an 85 year old, six inch clay pipe, for an additional 157 users.

The ongoing wastewater problems at Priors Orchard are well known locally, as well as being on record via the Parish Council and Planning online .

In 2019 Ofwat fined Southern Water £126 million pounds, and in September 2020 Southern Water were issued with a formal warning by the Environment Agency due to a failure at Thornham Treatment Plant. CDC have recently (2021) filed a complaint against Southern Water.

The Plan does not fulfil this critical community priority.

The statement that on SB2 para 5.28 'Southern Water confirm that new reinforcement is likely to be necessary' is an understatement! The probability of considerably more waste water breakdowns, and the potential for pollution and environmental damage in Chichester Harbour is glaringly obvious.

Our other serious concern is, as happens, untreated effluence is discharged into the harbour, which impacts on the quality of water, the health and safety of harbour users, including children, let alone the impact on marine life, environment and wildlife.

The current infrastructure needs serious and significant long term planning and immediate substantial investment rather than tap into what is already here. The Neighbourhood Plan needs to protect the environment, wildlife, health, safety and quality of life for the whole community, present and future.
