A thorough analysis of the consultation questionnaires has shown that fewer than half of the respondents expressed a preference for the Southbourne AND Nutbourne Plan, therefore the decision to 'go east' has not been made by the community.						
Throughout the Plan, terms such as 'land, routes, form, access, design, facilities' are frequently used. One glaring omission is 'human beings', the people that make a community, the people that invest and create atmosphere of wellbeing, supporting the local shops, the community and giving up time to aid the people of need and along the way making new friends. This can not be pushed to one side because of developer greed. We need new housing, but we need to do it in a sympathetic way to the village life that is here now.						
Continuing, there appears to be no consideration in the Plan for how it will provide solutions to health, mobility and indeed mental health issues to those residents affected by the lengthy construction phase.						
We now know that vital infrastructure such as roads will <u>not</u> be in place at commencement, or if ever, during the 15 year build process. When will this be done? when we have a significant issue in the community, affecting people's everyday lives? Prevention not cure, proactive not reactive is what we need to see from our Parish and Local District Councils. Where does this all feature in 'The Plan?'
