Chichester District Council (Tangmere) (No 2) Compulsory Purchase Order 2023 (the "Order") Objection on behalf of C.C. Projects

We act for C.C. Projects in relation to its remaining objection to the above-named Order as the freehold owners of Plots 10-13 of the Order Land.

We write to inform the Secretary of State that C.C. Projects has today completed a variation to a voluntary agreement with Countryside Properties (UK) Limited in respect of its interests in the Tangmere Strategic Development Location ('TSDL') and also entered into a separate deed of variation to an agreement with the acquiring authority, Chichester District Council, regulating the exercise of Order powers over its interests in the TSDL should the Order be confirmed by the Secretary of State.

Accordingly, and on that basis, please treat this email as formal confirmation that C.C. Projects hereby withdraws its objection to the Order dated 30 March 2023.

We would be grateful if you could please acknowledge safe receipt of this email and confirm that the objection to the Order has been withdrawn.
